Union Journeyman Carpenter:

The following is a brief description of the responsibilities if employed by AACCP as a Journeyman Carpenter. We are looking to hire a skilled Union Carpenter who is detail-oriented and has knowledge of various carpentry techniques. A successful applicant should be hardworking, reliable, punctual, and have good communication and organizational skills.

As a Union Carpenter, you would be expected to have a strong understanding of carpentry and the materials used in your trade,

Some specific qualifications/experience of a Union Carpenter might include:

1. Strong attention to detail, while focused on safety, quality, consistency, and production.
2. Measuring and cutting materials to precise dimensions, using different hand and power tools.
3. Assembling and installing metal framed walls, roofs, and other structural components of buildings, using screws, bolts, nails, and other fasteners.
4. Conduct repair work and new installation of different drywall products in a safe and timely manner.
5. Should be certified/trained in equipment such as boom lifts/scissor lifts.
6. Good communication skills.
7. Knowledge of mathematics.
8. Reading and interpreting blueprints, sketches, and other technical drawings to plan and execute carpentry projects.
9. Be able to pass a Drug Test.
10. Should be in good standings with the Union.
11. Physically fit and able to perform tasks such as lifting, climbing, and rigging.
12. Follow safety procedures and guidelines to ensure a safe work environment for yourself and others.
13. Open to new ideas, methods, teamwork, collaboration.
